Semiannual Political Party (PTY-CORP) Report due January 15, 2019

JANUARY 15, 2019: This notice is to remind you that as a state party chair you may have a semiannual political party report due January 15, 2019. This is the deadline for filing a political party report of corporate or labor organization contributions, expenditures, and loans (Form PTY-CORP). (Remember: If necessary, the campaign treasurer of your party's general-purpose political committee will report other contributions, expenditures, and loans on Form GPAC or MPAC.) The first day covered by the report is July 1, 2018, *or* the day after the date the last report ended, as applicable. The last day covered is December 31, 2018. You may start filing on January 1, 2019. If you think you received this notice in error, [contact our office immediately](#).

You must file this report only if:

- (1) your political party accepted or spent contributions from corporations or labor organizations during the reporting period; or
- (2) your political party maintained any amount of contributions from corporations or labor organizations accepted in earlier reporting periods.

ELECTRONIC FILING: The report must be filed electronically unless you qualify for the statutory exemption. To be in compliance with current requirements, you must use the campaign finance filing application found at www.ethics.state.tx.us/whatsnew/elf_filing_info.htm. **If this is your first time filing with the application**, we suggest you view the instructional videos also available at that link. When you file electronically, wait for a confirmation number. If you do not get a confirmation number, the report has NOT been filed. Remember, you can file a report as soon as the reporting period ends, and we encourage you to file as early as possible so that if you experience any problems, we can assist you.

TIMELY FILING: A report transmitted by Internet is considered timely filed if it is successfully transmitted in the correct format by midnight, Central Time Zone, January 15, 2019. A report eligible to be filed on paper is considered timely filed if it is deposited with the U.S. Post Office or placed in the hands of a common or contract carrier properly addressed with postage and handling charges prepaid, or hand-delivered to the Texas Ethics Commission in the correct format by the deadline. All paper reports must include the electronic filing exemption form, which is available on our website at www.ethics.state.tx.us/filinginfo/affs.htm.

LATE FILING PENALTY: The minimum late-filing penalty for a late January 2019 semiannual report is \$500.
