Second Called Special Session Report Due October 4, 2021

This notice is to remind you that statewide officeholders and candidates for statewide office, including judicial statewide officeholders and candidates for judicial statewide office, members of and candidates for the legislature, and specific-purpose committees supporting, opposing, or assisting those officeholders or candidates may have to file a special session report not later than the 30th day after the date of final adjournment of the second called special session. A report is required **ONLY IF** you accepted a political contribution (monetary, in-kind, pledges, non-bank loans) during the special session reporting period.

DUE DATE: The due date for filing the special session report is October 4, 2021, deadline extended due to weekend.

REPORTING PERIOD: The report must include political contributions accepted beginning on August 5, 2021 (the day the Governor signed the proclamation calling the special session), and continuing through September 2, 2021 (date of final adjournment of the special session). **Note:** Contributions accepted on August 5th and August 6th must be reported on ***both*** the first called special session report ***and*** the second called special session report.

CONTENT: A special session report includes contributions only, not expenditures. Also, the law requires all contributions included in a special session report to be itemized regardless of the amount. Additionally, please note that contributions reported on this special session report must be disclosed again on your next regular report (e.g., January 2022 semiannual).

ELECTRONIC FILING: The report must be filed electronically unless you qualify for the statutory exemption. To be in compliance with current requirements, you must use the campaign finance filing application found at www.ethics.state.tx.us/filinginfo/TECindex.php. Select your filer type from the left hand menu. **If this is your first time filing with the application**, we suggest you view the instructional videos also available at that link. When you file electronically, if you have successfully filed your report, you will see your report listed in your "Filed Reports" grid under "Manage My Reports" in the filing application. A confirmation number will also be sent to your email. ***If your report is listed in your "In-Progress Reports" grid, your report is NOT FILED.*** Remember, you can file a report as soon as the reporting period ends, and we encourage you to file as early as possible so that if you experience any problems, we can assist you.

TIMELY FILING: A report transmitted electronically is considered timely filed if it is successfully transmitted in the correct format by midnight, Central Time Zone, October 4, 2021. A report eligible to be filed on paper is considered timely filed if it is deposited with the U.S. Post Office or placed in the hands of a common or contract carrier properly addressed with postage and handling charges prepaid, or hand-delivered to the Texas Ethics Commission in the correct format by the deadline. All paper reports must include the electronic filing exemption form, which is available on our website at www.ethics.state.tx.us/forms/affd/affs.php.

LATE FILING PENALTY: The minimum civil penalty for filing a late special session report is \$500.
