Unlike the statute as it exists now, as amended by the bill there is no requirement that anyone tell us anything about these adult children (please compare to Section 15.0215, Election Code). Spouses are publicly disclosed in a variety of ways but there is no mechanism to determine whether an adult child lives with a judge, and what their name is. Accordingly, this bill requires us to devise a method to cross-check addresses and locate individuals at the same residence as a known judge, which would require both changes to software and an additional staff. Therefore we are estimating a cost of \$117,010 for the initial fiscal year and \$67,010 each additional year, or \$385,050 over a five year span. Due to software enhancement necessary to comply with this bill, the Commission would not be able to meet the September 1, 2021 effective date.
